QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

"I understand that there will be some door prizes given away. Do I need to register for them?"

Yes. There are two groups of door prizes. One group is for the Registered Attendees and one group is for the General Public. You can enter both drawings. Make sure you fill out the BLUE ticket (registered guests), included in your packet, and bring it by the Club Store. Orange tickets (general admission) are available as well. Door prizes will be drawn at ten minutes before the hour each hour the sales room is open. You must be present to win and you have 10 minutes to claim your prize at the Transformers Club Store.

You must be present to win any door prize. This includes the drawing for the two 2009 BotCon trips!

"Where is the Dealer Sales Room?" The Dealer Sales Room is on the third floor of the Duke Energy Center in the Junior Ballroom. Just follow the blue carpet and go up every escalator.

"Where is the Casino Night Awards Dinner?" The Casino Night Awards Dinner is on the second floor of the Duke Energy Center. Go to the orange carpet and look for the entrance at room 202-203. The event will start at 7:00 pm with food stations all around the room. Bring your casino play money to use at the gaming tables. You can purchase a chance for prizes and more play money by donating \$20 to Hasbro Childrens' Hospital for a prize balloon. For your enjoyment, there will be casino games and bingo (room 212) available. At the end of the evening, we will have an auction using your prize money. When the gaming ceases, take your chips to the nearest dealer and they will provide you with a bidders card. After the auction starts, no more prize money will be available and if you want to team up with someone, make sure you turn your chips in together to receive one bidders card. There will be some great one-of-a-kind prizes available so bid high to win!

"What should I wear to the Casino Night Awards Dinner?" Dress is smart casual. This means shirts with collars and no shorts.

"I think I want to attend a panel. Where are they located?" All panels and seminars are on the second floor of the Duke Energy Center in room 206. Take the escalator down one floor from the Junior ballroom toward the parking garage and take the hall on your right. This is in the orange carpet area.

"Where is the Video Room and when is it open?" The Video Room is in room 211 in the Duke Energy Center and is open during all show hours on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

"How do I enter the drawing for the two trips to the BotCon 2009?"

Each Primus attendee is eligible to enter the drawing. To get your entry ticket, you MUST return your COMPLETED Convention Evaluation form (you will find this in your convention paperwork folder) to the Club Store to get your GOLD ticket. This will help us improve future shows. You MUST turn in your evaluation on Sunday before 3:00 pm. Evaluations will not be accepted on Saturday. You also MUST be present at 3:00 pm on Sunday in order to win the trip. Don't leave early!

"Are there any more Convention Packages available?" "Can I get extra figures for my set?"
Unfortunately we are sold out. We do have a few 2005 Descent into Evil sets. We also have some souvenirs available, see below. "Are there any other official BotCon Souvenirs?"

Yes. We have two figure packs, and several other BotCon memorabilia items. Come by the club store and check them all out! The figure sets are Blurr, Sideswipe and Rampage (LE 1,100 sets); Megatron, Rodimus and Divebomb (LE 1,100 sets). There are also a limited number of BotCon Hats, T-shirts (2 versions this year!), and Programs. Also there are two different BotCon lithographs available this year one by Alex Milne and the other by Jake Isenberg. Each print is a limited edition of 500 with 150 signed. Both versions will be available at the show.

"I have to leave early and I thought I would give my badge to my friend so that he can attend the Casino Night Awards Dinner. Can I do this?" No. Each package is registered to the original purchaser. If anyone else is found wearing your name badge, the badge will be revoked and the person will be escorted out of the show. This is a security issue.

"Where is an ATM Machine?" There is one in the lobby of the Duke Energy Center.

"How do I ship my items home?" PakMail will be there. Check for their booth in the Sales Room.

"I am not a member of the Transformers' Collectors Club. How can I join?" Stop by the Club Store. An official membership allows you to purchase the upcoming Club exclusives and provides you with a bi-monthly newsletter and a free 30-word ad each month. In addition, you will get a discount on next year's BotCon packages. Anyone who signs up at BotCon will start their membership on 4-01-08. You will get a free Breakaway figure and Club Magazine back issues for 2008.

"Is there really a 'Virtual Convention' being loaded to the Internet from Cincinnati?" Yes. You can check out all the action from your laptop (or when you get home) by pointing your browser at BotCon.com. You might even see yourself in one of the pictures! These files will stay on-line as a permanent record of the convention.

"I had such a great time! I want to go to next year's BotCon. When will the registration packets be available?" All future convention information will be announced in the Transformers Collectors' Club Magazine and website.


